THE LORAX. The Lorax is an allegory. An allegory is a tale in which objects and actions in the story have meanings outside the story. Characters often stand for abstract ideas like charity, greed, or envy. An allegory is a story with two meanings: a literal one and a symbolic one. If you miss a question or spell it wrong, you can fix it later.
