After an embryo implants in a uterus's wall, but before its cells differentiate, the most common manifestation of deviant development is the embryo's death. Additionally, organisms sensitive to teratogens are more susceptible to having their embryos die than they are to having those embryos develop with abnormalities; the converse holds for lineages of organisms somewhat resistant to teratogens.
