A baby with HLHS also may have a hole between the left and right upper chamber of his heart. This is called an atrial septal defect, and it can cause too much blood to flow to the lungs. Signs of HLHS may not show up until a few days after birth. For the first day or two, a baby's heart can adjust to the defect.

Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome: What You Need to Know ...

Doctors usually use an echocardiogram to diagnose hypoplastic left heart syndrome. This test uses high-pitched sound waves that bounce off your baby's heart to produce moving images that can be viewed on a video screen. If your baby has hypoplastic left heart syndrome, the echocardiogram will show a smaller than normal left ventricle and aorta.

Hypoplastic left heart syndrome (HLHS) is one of the most complex cardiac defects seen in the newborn and remains probably the most challenging to manage of all congenital heart defects. It is one of a group of cardiac anomalies that can be grouped together under the description single ventricle defects.

Hypoplastic left heart syndrome (HLHS) is a rare congenital heart defect where left part of the heart and its structures-left ventricle, mitral valve, aortic valve, aorta- are underdeveloped. It is more commonly seen in males. Left part of the heart is responsible for pumping oxygenated blood to the rest of the body.

Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome - Life Expectancy ...

Hypoplastic left heart syndrome is a congenital condition (the baby is born with it). Underdevelopment of the heart structures occurs during the first eight weeks of pregnancy. There is often no clear reason for the development of congenital heart defects.

Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome (HLHS) - Cleveland Clinic

The clinical presentations of HLHS occur most frequently between days 1 and 3 of life, and include respiratory distress with tachypnea and mild cyanosis, shock, and less commonly, severe cyanosis (31). Most infants die within the first two weeks of life, with an average age at death of 4.5 days (31, 33, 34).

Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome In hypoplastic left heart syndrome, the left side of the heart - the part that pumps oxygenated blood to the rest of the body - is underdeveloped. Its two chambers, called the left atrium and the left ventricle, and their valves may be tiny, blocking the flow of oxygenated blood from the lungs.

Hypoplastic left heart syndrome (HLHS) is a spectrum of heart diseases in which the left-heart structures are underdeveloped. These structures include the mitral valve, the left ventricle, the aortic valve, and the aorta. HLHS is a congenital heart defect that begins during pregnancy.

Hypoplastic left heart syndrome is a condition where the left lower pumping chamber (left ventricle) of the heart does not develop properly so is much smaller than usual. The mitral valve between the left ventricle and the upper left filling chamber (left atrium) is often closed or very small.
